School Facility Type	Description Name
Public school campus	<p>This is where the vast majority of students receive services.</p> <p>The student population in this School Type Facility category could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals with and without disabilities. For example: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Services received on college campuses ▪ Services received on vocations sites. ▪ Services received in a day school or day treatment offered by a private agency whose program is not limited to students with disabilities.
Separate school	These schools are designed specifically for students with disabilities and facility does not have a residential component.
Residential facility	Facility must be designed specifically for students with disabilities and facility has a residential component.
Homebound/Hospital	<p>Facility is a hospital or home.</p> <p>The student population in this School Type Facility category could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • students who are receiving services in hospital programs • students who are receiving services in homebound programs (e.g. medically fragile) <p>Note: This facility type does <u>not</u> include students whose parents have opted to home-school.</p>
Correctional facility	<p>Facility is a correctional institution, detention center, state prison or county jail.</p> <p>The student population in this School Type Facility category could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students who receive services in short-term detention facilities • Students who receive services in prison
Accredited, Non-Public or Home-Schooled	<p>Facility is an accredited, non-public school or home-school.</p> <p>The student population in this School Type Facility category could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students who receive special education and related service at public expense in an accredited, non-public school • Students who are home-schooled.
