



Web IEP 2010 Interim Release August 20, 2009

The Consent for Evaluation Form has been modified to collect additional data. The changes include:

Consent Type

- In the top portion of the form, the type "Other" has been removed. The types "Full and Individual Initial Evaluation" and "Reevaluation" remain.

Demographic Information

- Resident District and Building as well as Attending District and Building continue to be four (4) separate fields although the form may lead one to believe otherwise.

Additional Text

- Additional text and checkboxes have been inserted after the text "Description of the evaluation procedures, tests, records or reports that were used as a basis for the proposed evaluation."

New Suspected Disability and Assessment Checkboxes

- All current items from the above text to "For reevaluations:" area has been removed. This includes documentation of persons responsible for assessments.
- There are two new sets of checkboxes on the form, representing evaluation domains. One set is specifically for Initial evaluations. These boxes indicate domains where a disability is suspected. The second set of checkboxes is utilized to indicate the domains where an assessment is needed. There is no one to one relationship between the domains in the two columns. Assessments can be requested (on the right) without a matching disability suspected (on the left).
- The assessment checkbox (right) will always be active, regardless of the meeting type.

- If the Full and Individual Initial Evaluation is checked at the top of the form, the domain disability suspected checkbox column (left) will be active.
- If Reevaluation is checked at the top, all of the disability suspected checkbox column (left) will be unchecked and will be "read-only". Checking "Reevaluation" at the top of the form will remove any check marks from the Disability Suspected (left) column.

Existing Reevaluation Checkboxes

- The two checkboxes under the heading "For Reevaluations:" will be controlled by a combination of the new column of assessment checkboxes and the type of evaluation at the top of the form.
- If the Consent type is "Full and Individual Initial Evaluation, these two checkboxes will be read-only and not selectable.
- If the Consent type is "Reevaluation" and any one of the seven (7) checkboxes under assessment domains is checked, the box for "The IEP team has recommended additional assessment." shall be checked.
- If the Consent type is "Reevaluation" and none of the seven (7) checkboxes under assessment domains is checked, the box for "The IEP has not recommended additional assessment." shall be checked.
