

86% of Sam's classmates were low risk on the 1st grade fall DIBELS scores for PSF and NWF. Sam is the only student in his class who has yet to master the 20 sight words expected to date.

- other plausible explanations that may account for the child's lack of educational performance, (i.e., lack of appropriate instruction, language other than English, lack of prior knowledge, cultural expectations, attendance or mobility):

While Sam missed 10 days of school during his kindergarten year, he received direct instruction on content he missed during individual teacher time and parents completed practice activities at home. There are no plausible explanations regarding Sam's performance related to exclusionary factors.
